Eligibility Guidelines

- 1. Someone in the applicant's immediate family must be a customer of Denver Savings Bank (parent, grandparent, brother/sister).
- 2. Must be accepted in an accredited college, university or community college.
- 3. Must be attending a high school in Bremer or Black Hawk County & have an expected graduation date of Spring 2024.
- 4. College students are not eligible for this scholarship.
- 5. Scholarship is to be applied toward tuition fees only.
- 6. Children of Denver Savings Bank employees are not eligible.

The following criteria will be considered in selecting recipients.

- 1. Academic performance and honors, ACT score and class rank.
- 2. Essay indicating your professional goals and how your occupation contributes to the betterment of our community.
- 3. Financial need.
- 4. How the student plans to contribute financially to his/her education.
- 5. Two letters of recommendation that demonstrate the student's potential for successful completion of a course of study and moral character.
